



SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE NORTH DAKOTA MEDICAID 1915(i) STATE PLAN AMENDMENT

The North Dakota Medicaid 1915(i) State Plan Amendment allows North Dakota Medicaid to pay for additional home and community-based services to support individuals with behavioral health conditions.

For individuals to be eligible to receive services reimbursed through the 1915(i), individuals must meet the following criteria:

1. Age 0+; and
2. Enrolled in ND Medicaid or Medicaid Expansion; and
3. Have a household income at or below 150% of Federal Poverty Level; and
4. Receive a WHODAS score of 25 or above; and
5. Reside in and will receive services in a setting meeting the federal home and community-based setting requirements, and
6. Have a diagnosis of substance use disorder, mental illness or brain injury

Eligible individuals will work with a Care Coordinator to develop an individualized plan of services, which may include the following:

- Training and Supports for Unpaid Caregivers
- Community Transitional Services
- Benefits Planning
- Non-Medical Transportation
- Respite
- Prevocational Training
- Supported Education
- Supported Employment
- Housing Support
- Family Peer Support
- Peer Support
