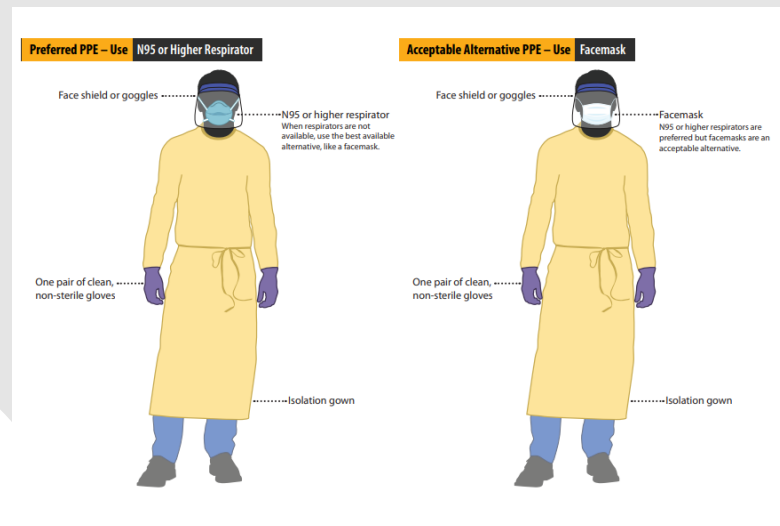


# Enhanced Droplet Precautions

Should be used with patient or resident who have suspected or confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection.



## Ensure Appropriate Placement

- Patient/resident should be moved to a single-person room with a dedicated bathroom.
- Door should remain closed (if safety allows)

## Use Personal Protective Equipment Appropriately

- Don fit-tested NIOSH-approved N95, gown, gloves and eye protection before entering the room.
- All PPE besides respirator and eye protection are doffed inside the room.

## Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGPs)

- AGPs should take place in airborne infection isolation room (AIIR), if possible.
- Limit HCP in the room while AGPs are performed.
- Door should remain closed during procedure.
- Clean/disinfect surfaces after the allotted time.

## Limit Transport and Movement

- Transport outside of room only for medically necessary purposes.
- Communicate suspected/confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection before transferring patient/resident outside of the facility.

## Safety of Visitors

- Educate visitors on the risk of an in person visit.
- Provide instruction on hand hygiene, PPE, and limiting surfaces touched.
- Instruct visitors to only visit patient/residents' room.
