

1915(i) Provider Enrollment/Onboarding FAQ

How does my agency get started?

Refer to the 1915(i) Web Page <u>How to Become a Provider</u> and follow the steps outlined.

How long does the enrollment process take?

Becoming a provider ready to receive referrals and provide services can take several months. Completing the required steps thoroughly and accurately and responding promptly to requests from Provider Enrollment will ensure the process moves as quickly as possible.

Once both the group and individual enrollments are approved, there are a trainings and additional steps required. If you have navigated the enrollment process without the assistance of the 1915(i) team, the next step would be to contact nd1915i@nd.gov for guidance on how to proceed.
