

If you experience an emergency or have a planned/unplanned event, there may be funding to assist with the cost of respite care.

The Lifespan Respite Care Grant Service may offer funding for a short break to family caregivers who are experiencing events such as:

- Caregiver illnesses, medical appointments and hospitalizations
- Emergencies
- Funerals, weddings, graduations and vacations
- Waiting for approval for other respite funding sources
- Other reasons as approved by the program administrator
