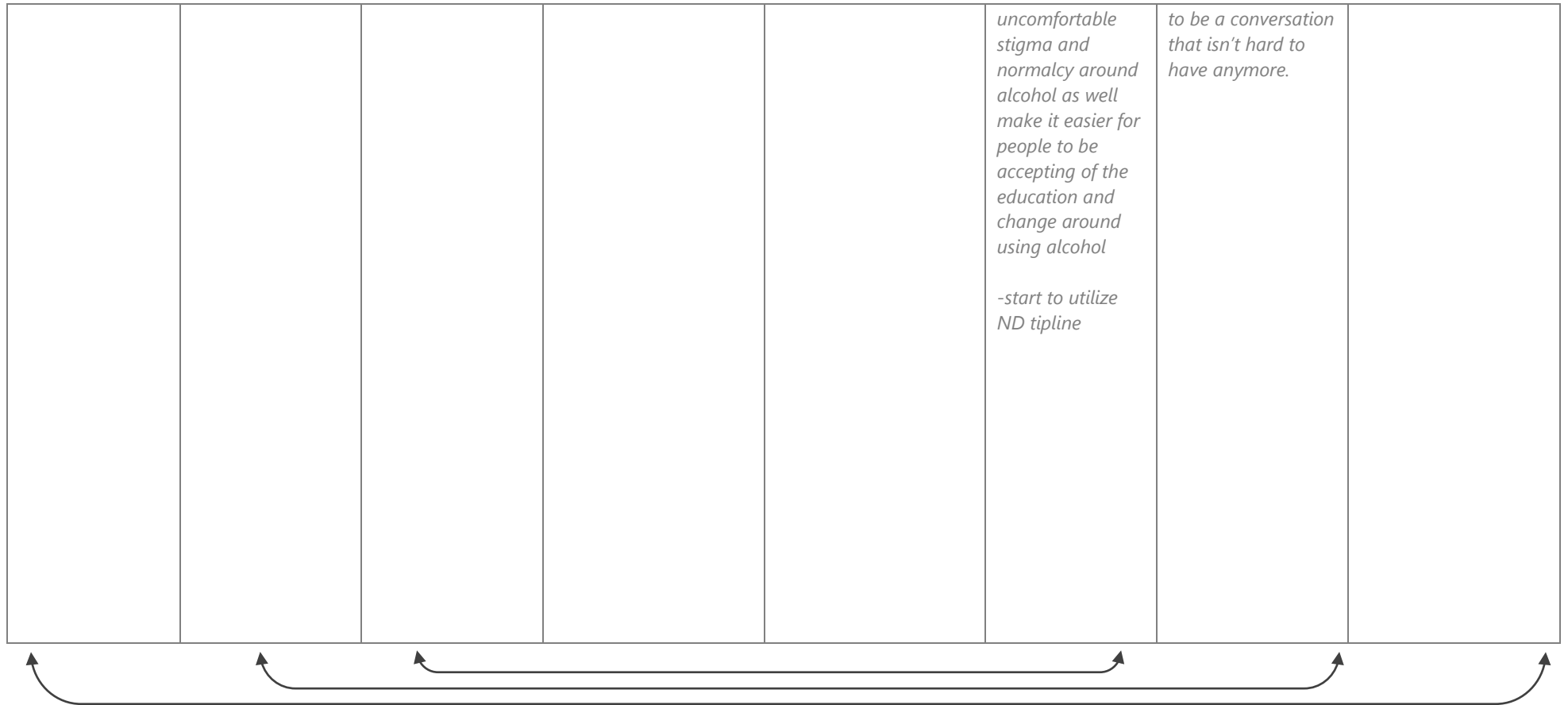

Youth Underage Drinking - 92% of adults agree underage drinking is a problem in their community (ND Community Readiness Survey, 2022) -53.85% of participants believe underage drinking is a problem in Sargent County (10.2023 Survey Monkey)	Why is it a problem in your community? -23.7% of high school students currently drink alcohol. (YRBS-2021 Results) -20.6% of middle school students currently drink alcohol. (YRBS-2021 Results)	What does the problem specifically look like in your community/what is the behavior? -Social Norm- 24% of ND agree that drinking among teenagers is acceptable. (2022 ND Community Readiness Report) - Lack of Enforcement- 88.4% of participants say that they would like increased Law Enforcement	What is the one environmental change you can implement to impact your identified problem? Sargent County would like to make an environmental change to the social norm regarding underage drinking in our community.	What are all the steps that must happen to implement the environmental change? -See Attachment A- Activity Implementation Guide	Measures the local condition – what are you doing to address the problem? - provide alternative events to encourage youth to participate in positive activities and providing education to youth and adults at these alternative events. -provide RBST and ID scanners to local establishments -create the discussion... talking more about the	Measures the intervening variable – what you are doing to reduce access? -measure number of ID scans from ID scanners. We would like to see an increase from 0 scans. -we want to see all 3 of our schools open to evidence-based curriculum taught in schools. -we would like to see at least 50 anonymous tips submitted each year. -normalize the conversation! We want substance use	Measures the impact to the problem – are you seeing long-term behavior change? -Over the next 3 year, we would like the % of participants on our YRBS survey to decrease 3-5% when asked if youth are currently using alcohol. -we would like the mindset of the community to not think of underage alcohol consumption as a social norm. -we would like to see permanent ID scanners at all local retailers
