Problem Statement:

There is a high incidence of underage drinking in the City of Jamestown.

Supporting Data:

- 20.1% of Jamestown Middle School students reported ever drinking alcohol. (JMS YRBS, 2021)
- 37% of young adults (ages 18-20) in North Dakota report binge drinking in the last 30 days. (Young Adult Survey, 2020)

Goal 1	Reduce retail access of alcohol to young adults in the City of Jamestown.
Objective 1:	Increase availability and utilization of ID scanners in popular college bars.
Objective 2:	Increase availability and access to Responsible Beverage Server Training (RBST).
