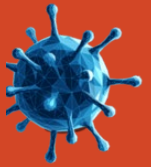


KEEP GERMS FROM BEING BREATHED IN

Hand Hygiene

The most effective infection prevention measure.

- Do correct hand hygiene every time.
- Clean hands-wash with soap and water or use hand sanitizer for at least 20 seconds.
- Germs from respiratory droplets can be spread through touch.



Source Control

Stop germs from spreading

- Wear a mask if you have a cough or are going to be around someone who has a cough.
- Use other PPE as recommended.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.
- Dispose of tissue immediately after use.



Good Ventilation

Good ventilation systems help filter and remove particulates and germs

- Do not block vents or air intakes.
- Proper cleaning-regular cleaning of surfaces including any fans, air vents, air return vents, equipment vents.
- Keep your equipment vents (eg. vacuum) free of dust and change filters regularly.
- Keep the doors closed to rooms with certain isolation precautions.
- Keep the windows closed to allow the system to work properly.
