

Housing Stabilization Application Checklist

Are you or anyone in your household experiencing homelessness? Apply to see if you qualify for re-housing assistance from NDRH Housing Stabilization.

Homelessness: an individual or family who lacks a fixed, regular, adequate nighttime residence. This includes a living situation where you are temporarily doubled up with another household or transitioning out of a treatment or corrections facility.

Documents to have when you apply:

- Government-issued photo ID (if available)
- Social Security Number for all household members over 18
- Proof of current income (if available), such as:
 - Most recent tax returns
 - Most recent 1099
 - Two most recent paystubs
- Copies of any past-due amount to a previous housing provider or utility company that is causing a barrier to housing (if applicable)
