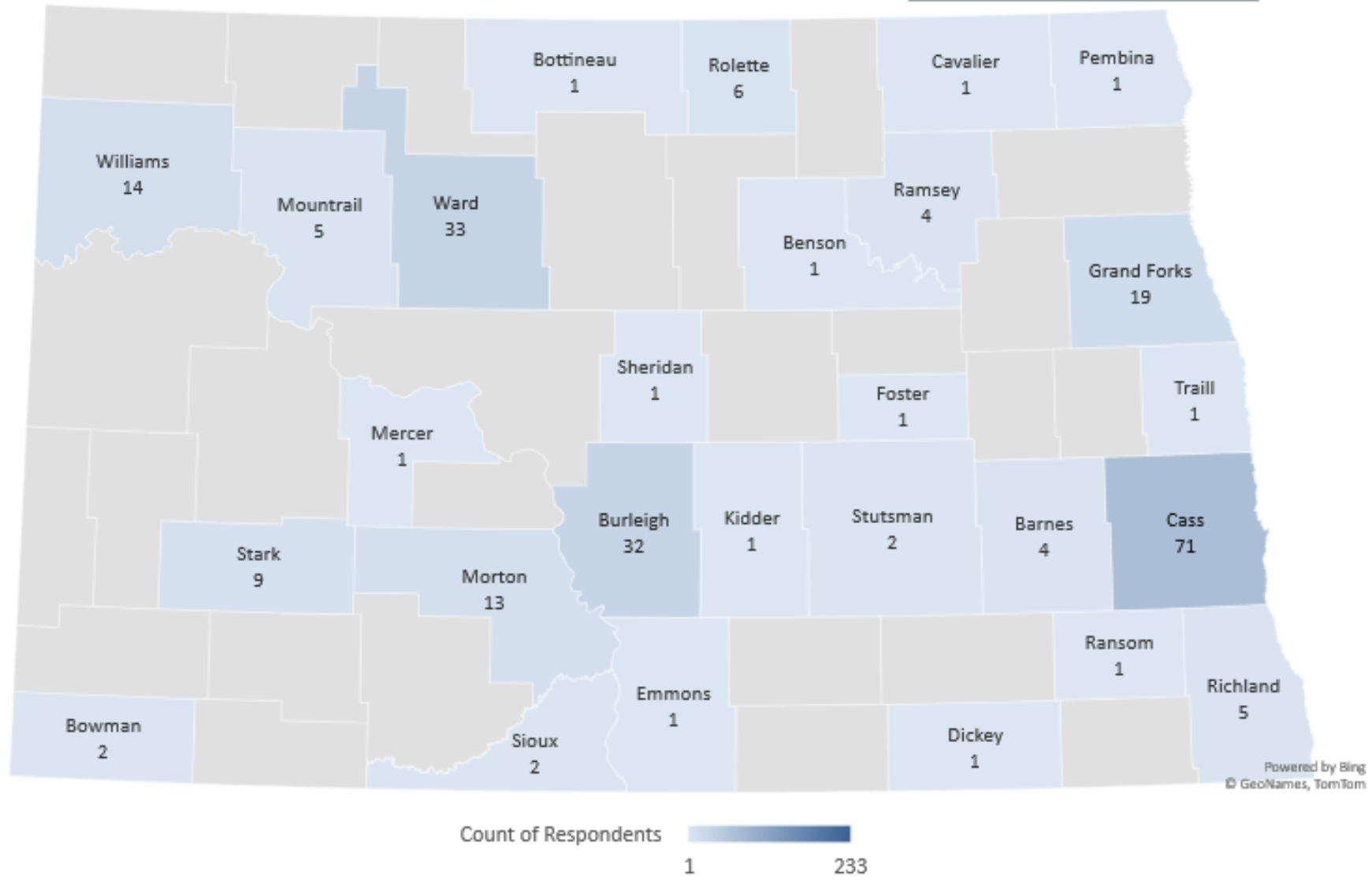

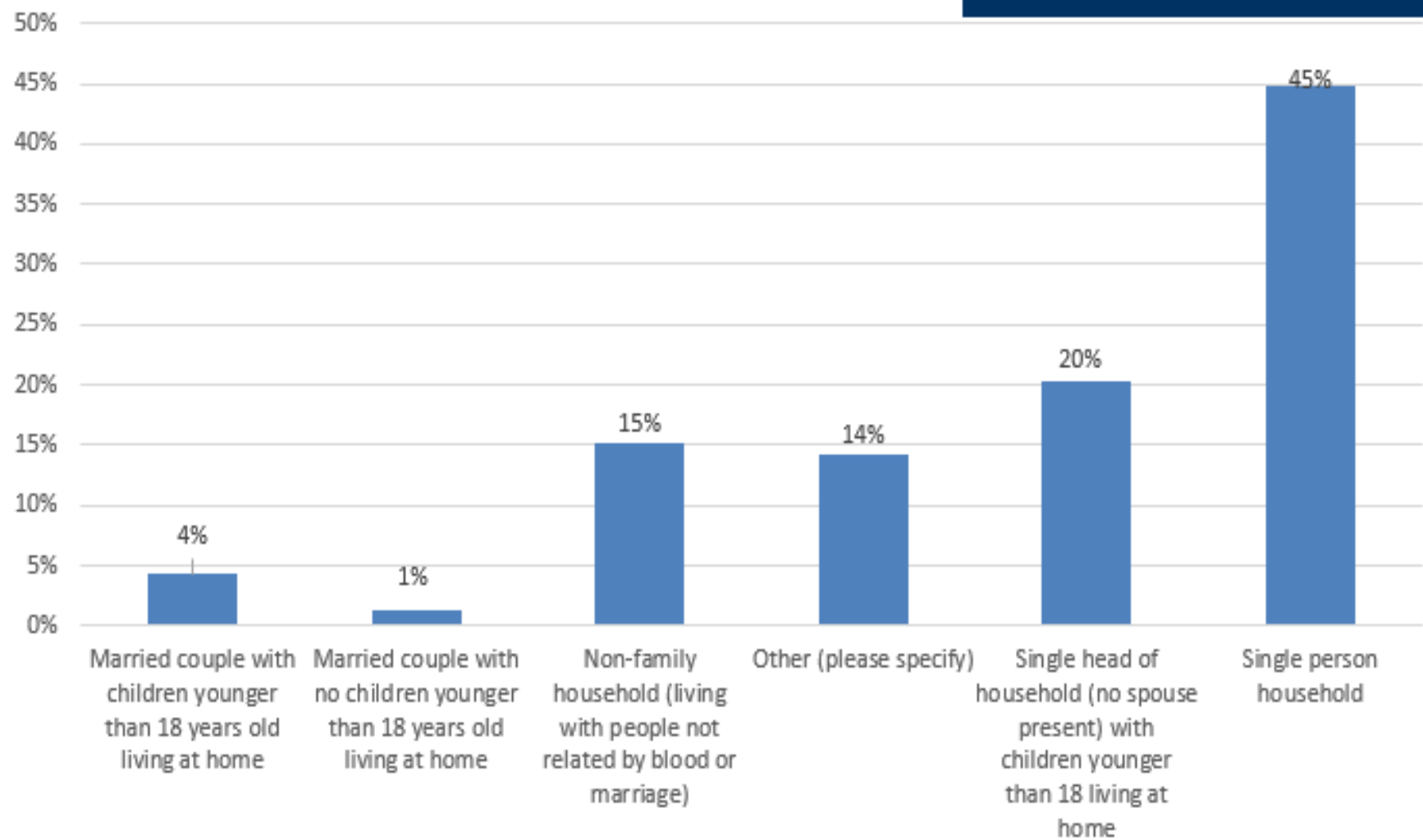

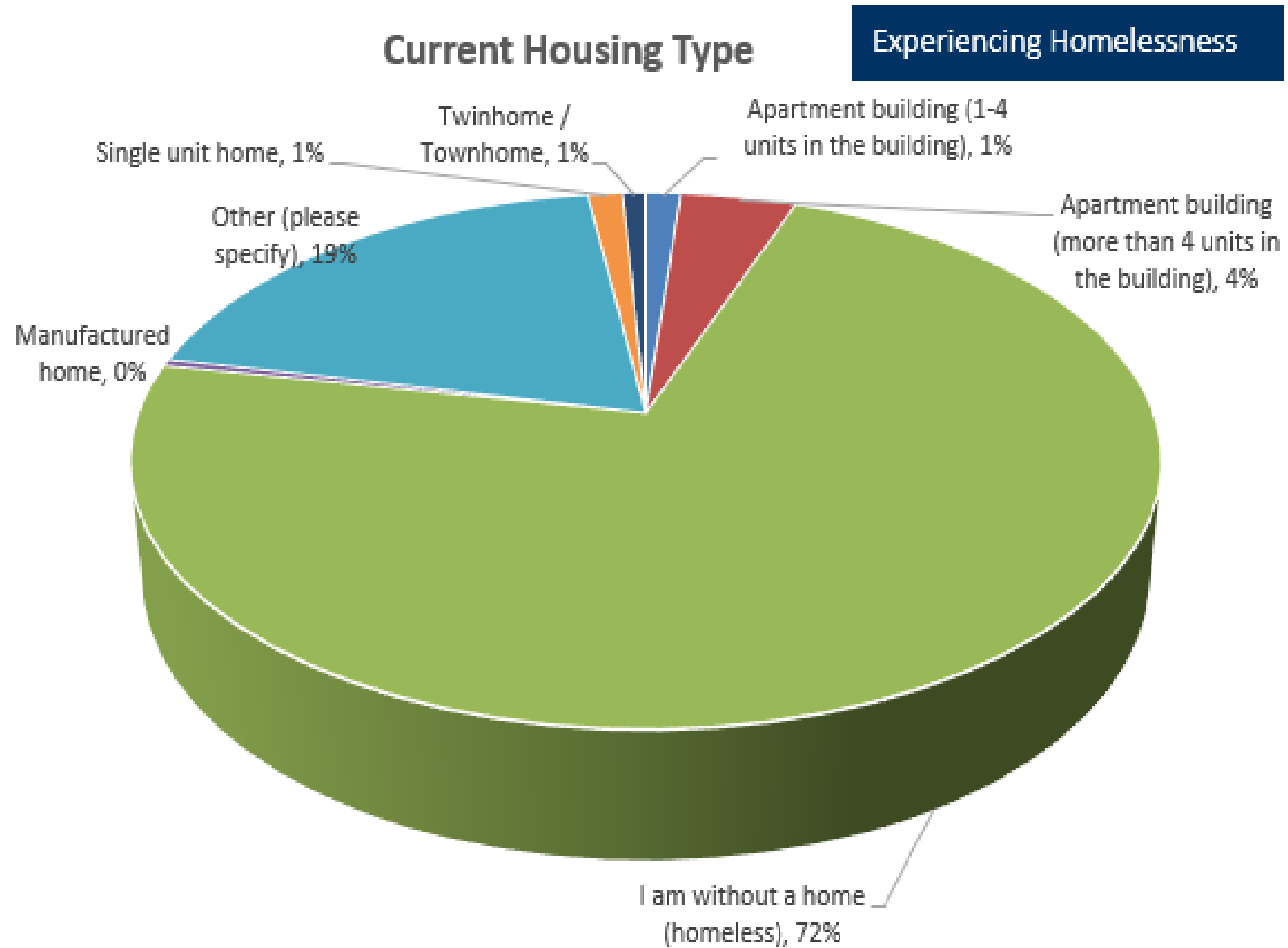

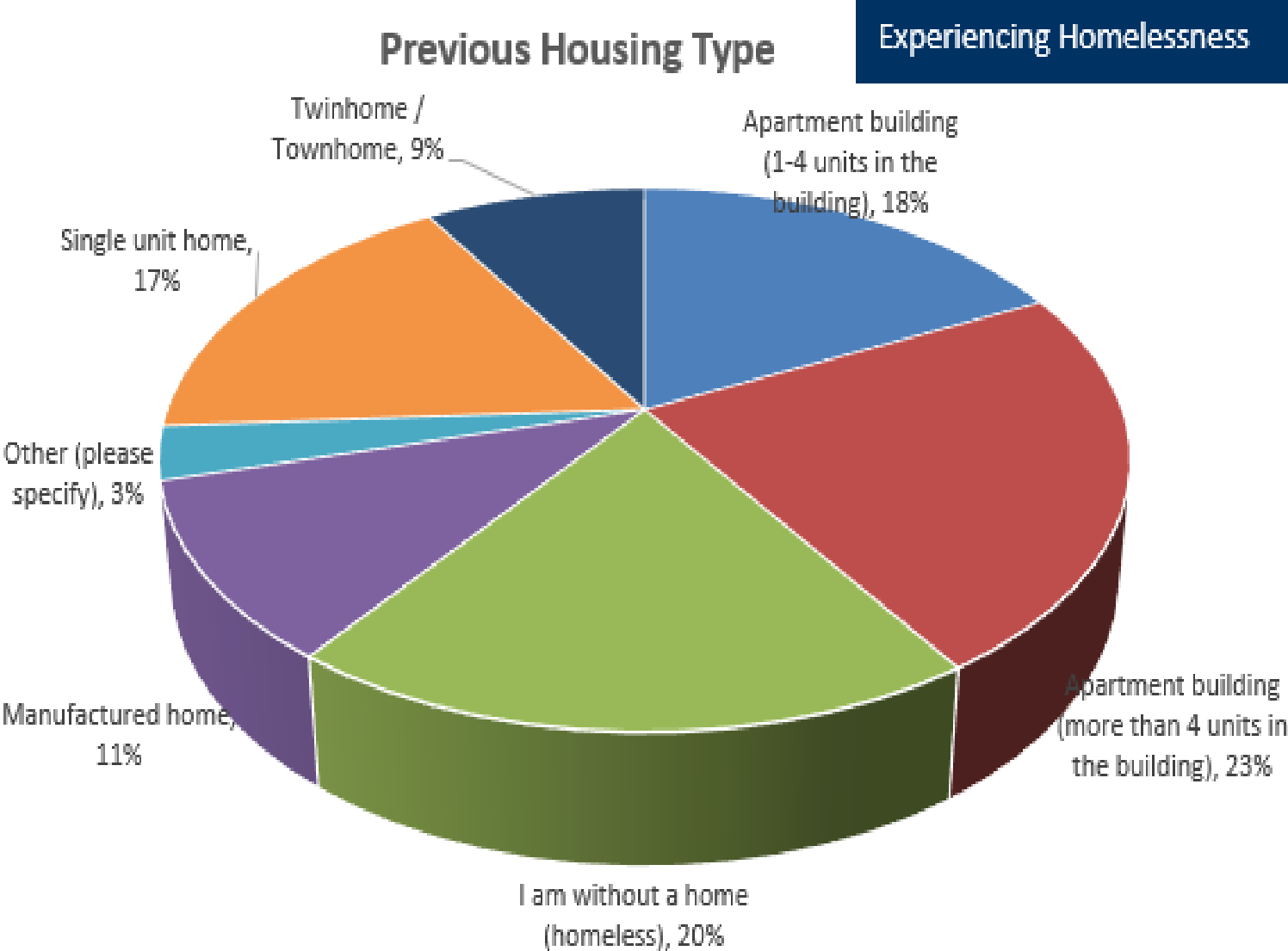

# WHAT TYPE OF HOUSING DO YOU LIVE IN TODAY?

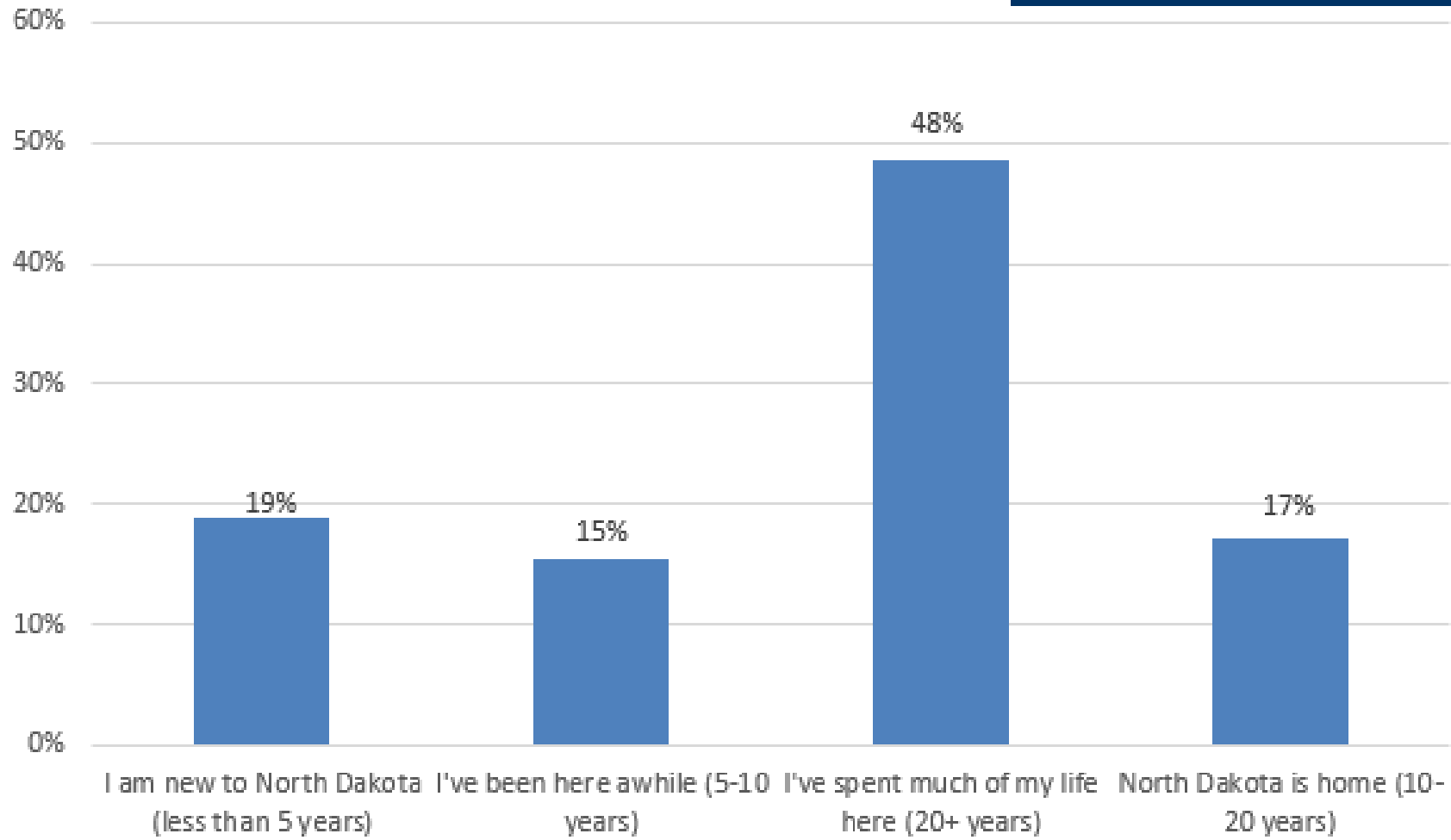


# WHAT TYPE OF HOUSING UNITS HAVE YOU LIVED IN?

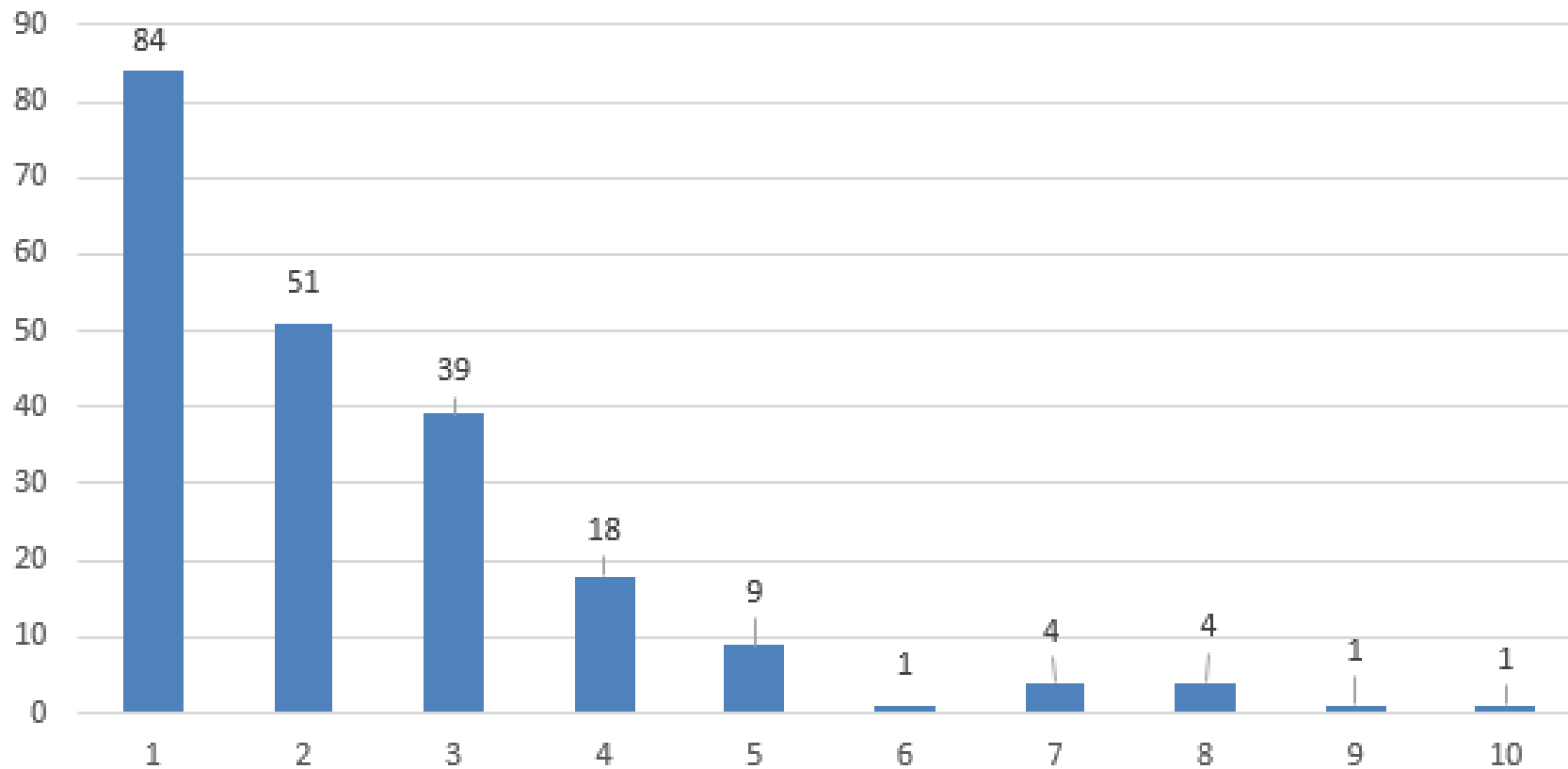

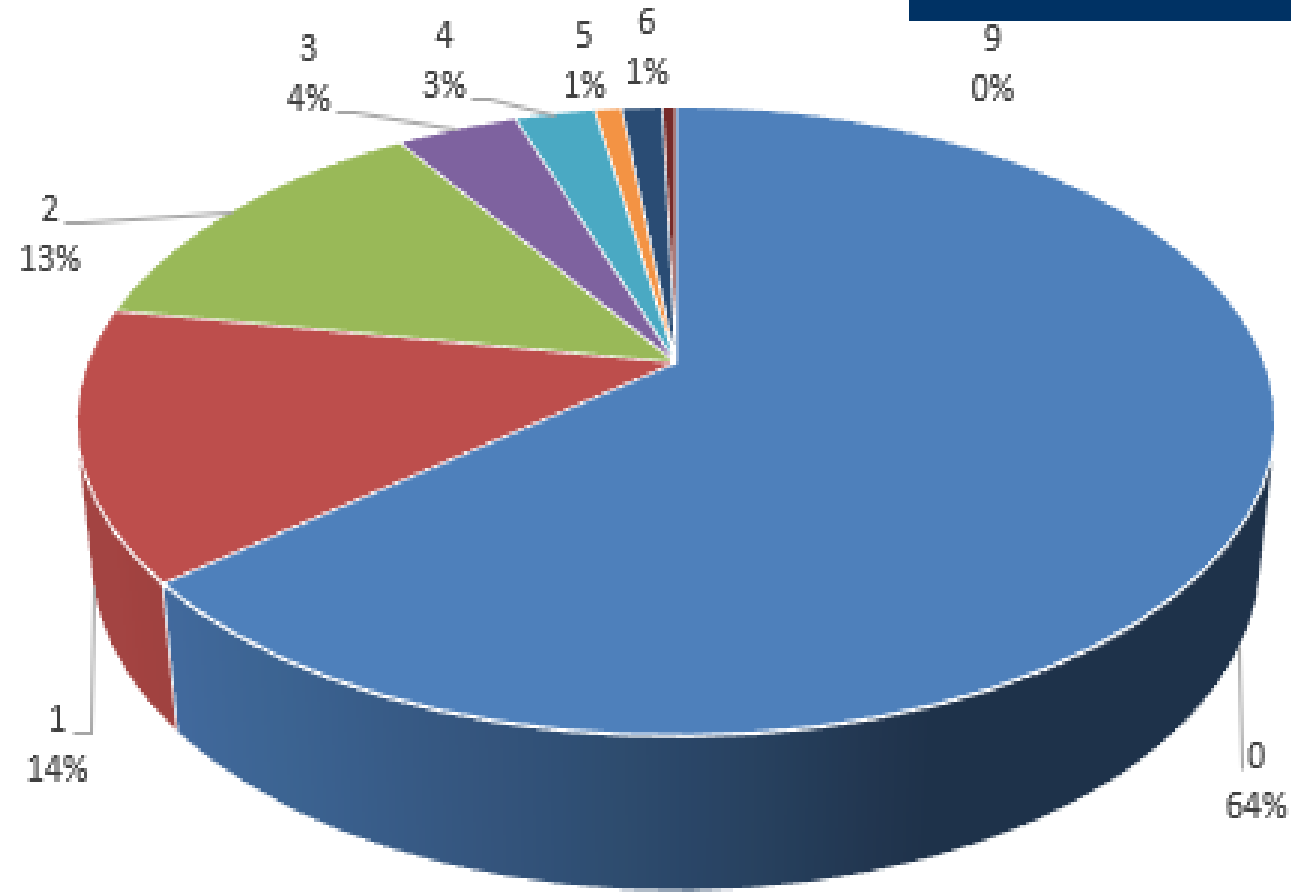

How many people under 18 years-old currently live in your household?

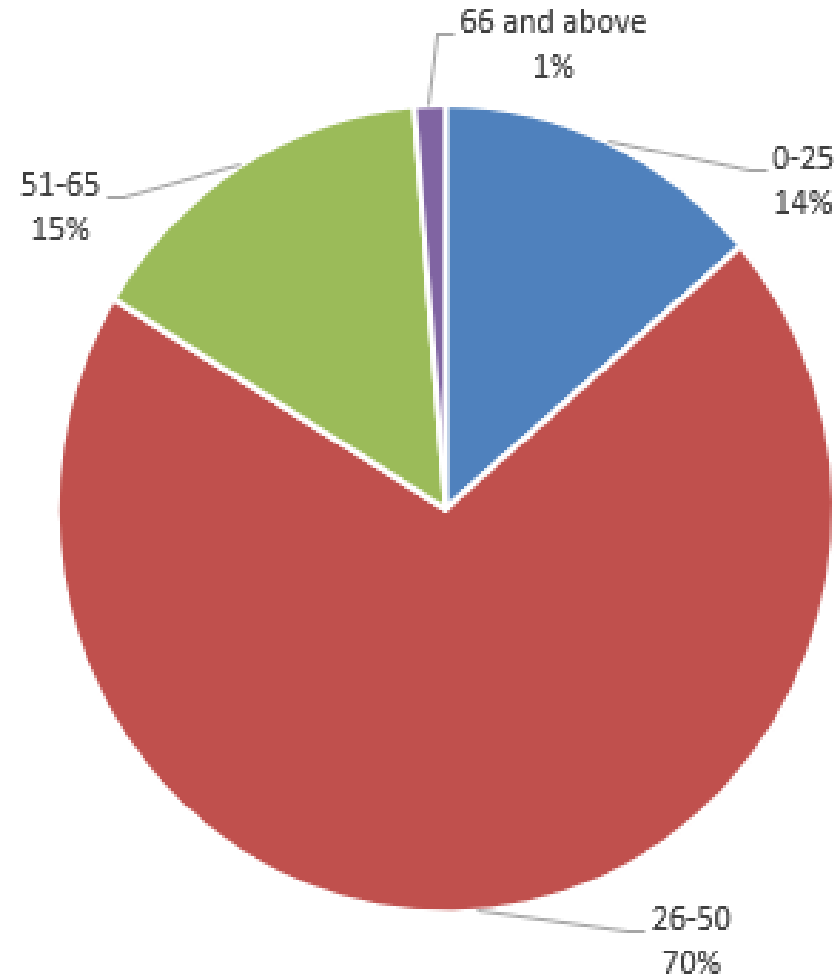

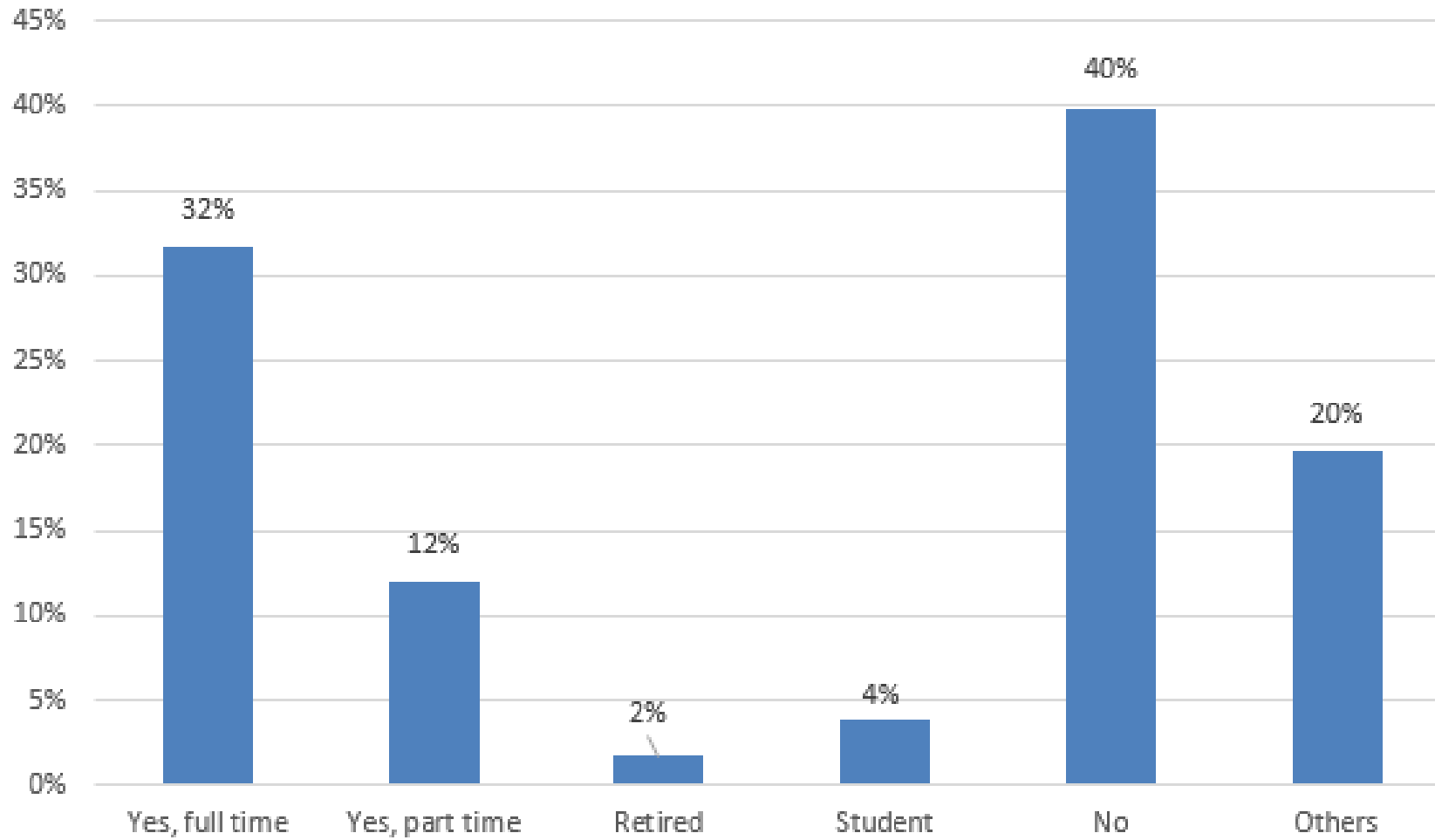
## Age distribution of survey Respondents

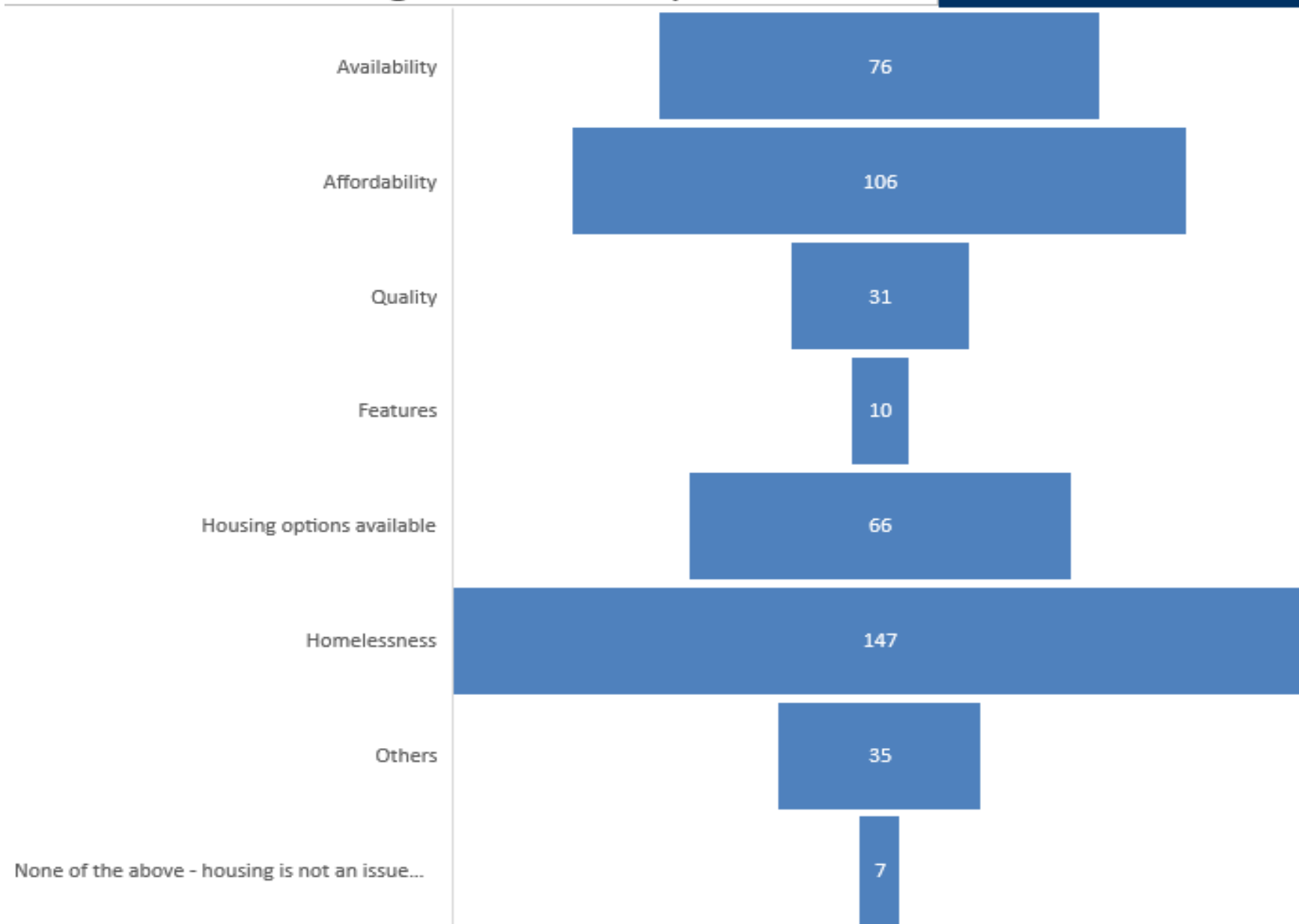

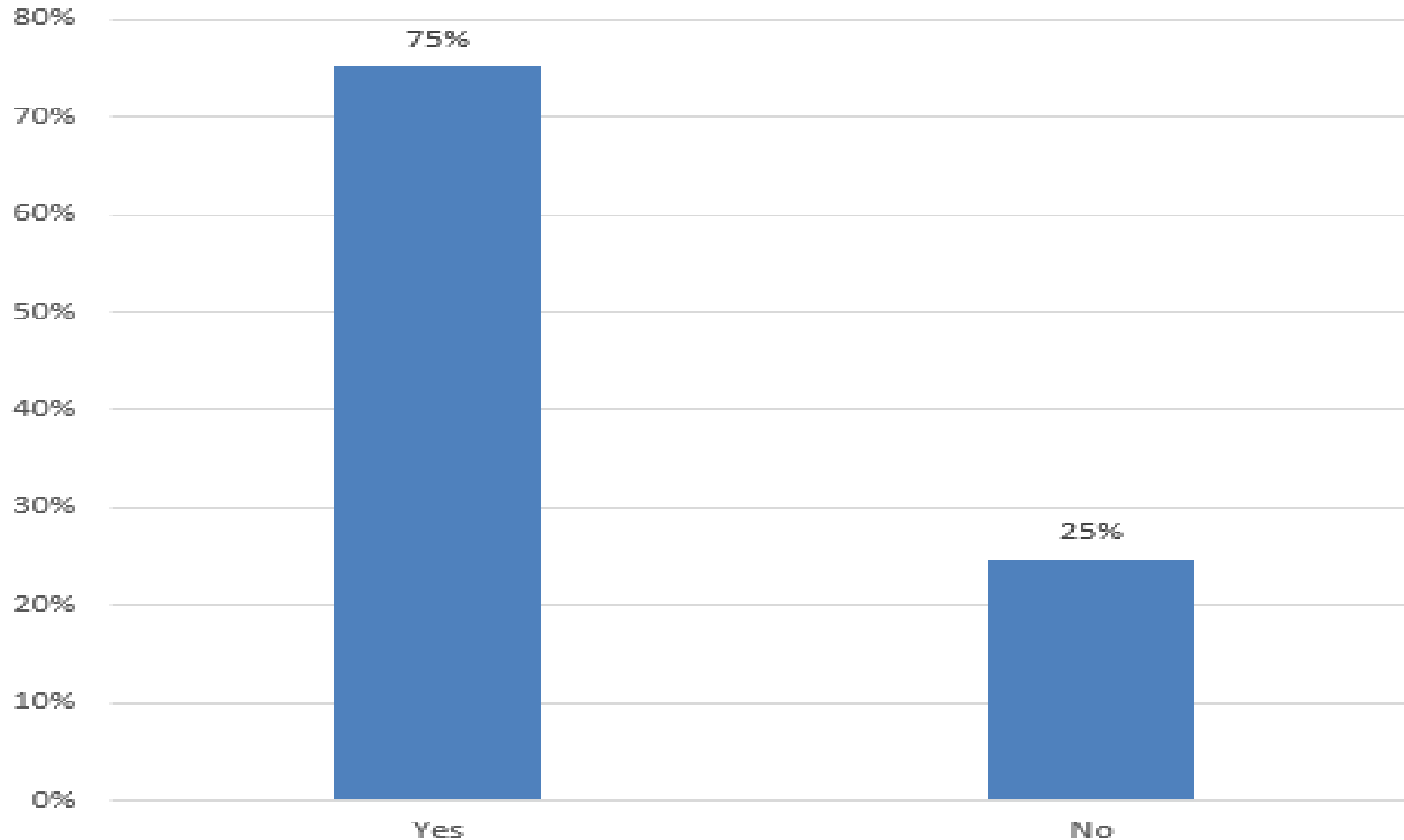

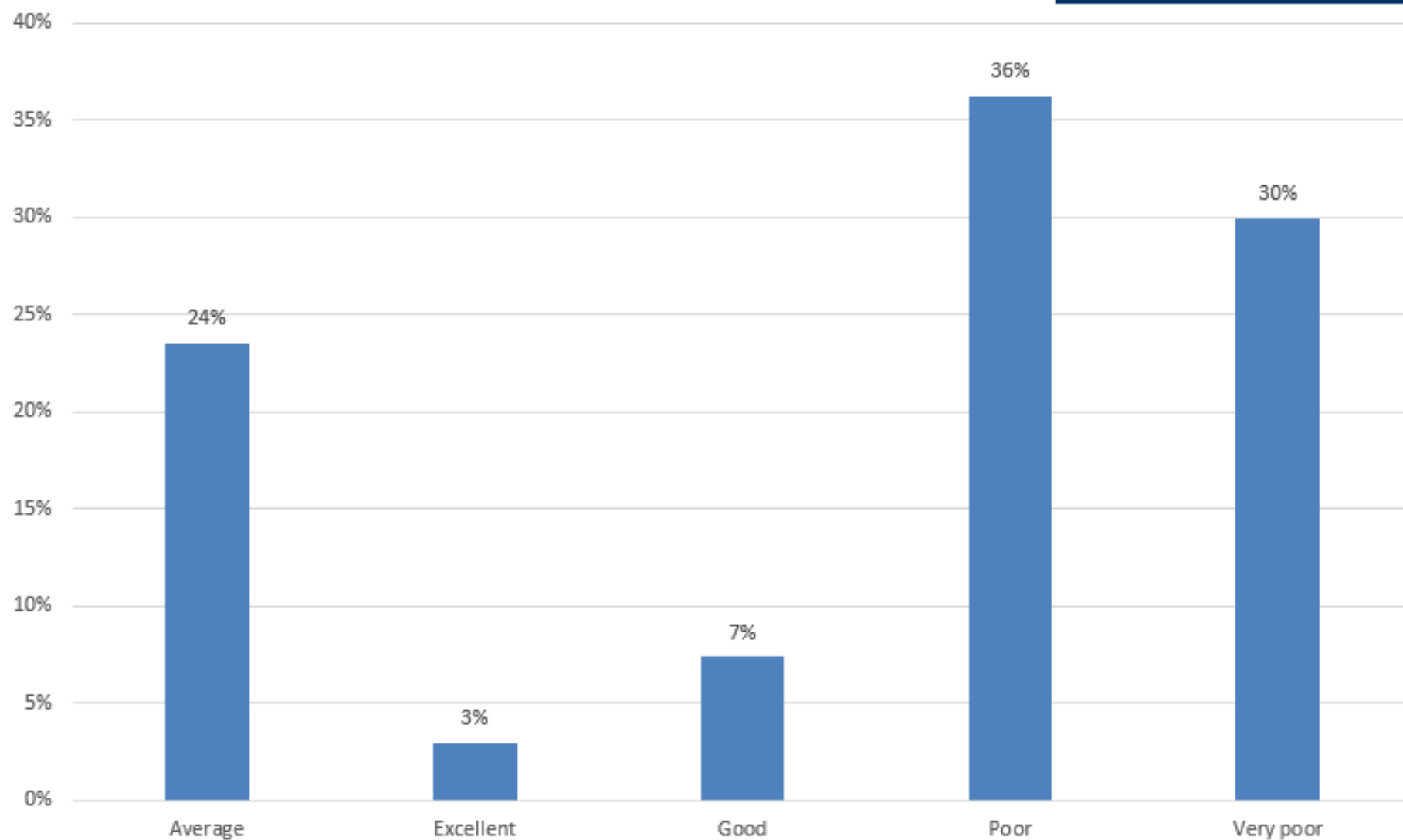
In terms of your household's needs, are you satisfied with the range of housing options available in your community?

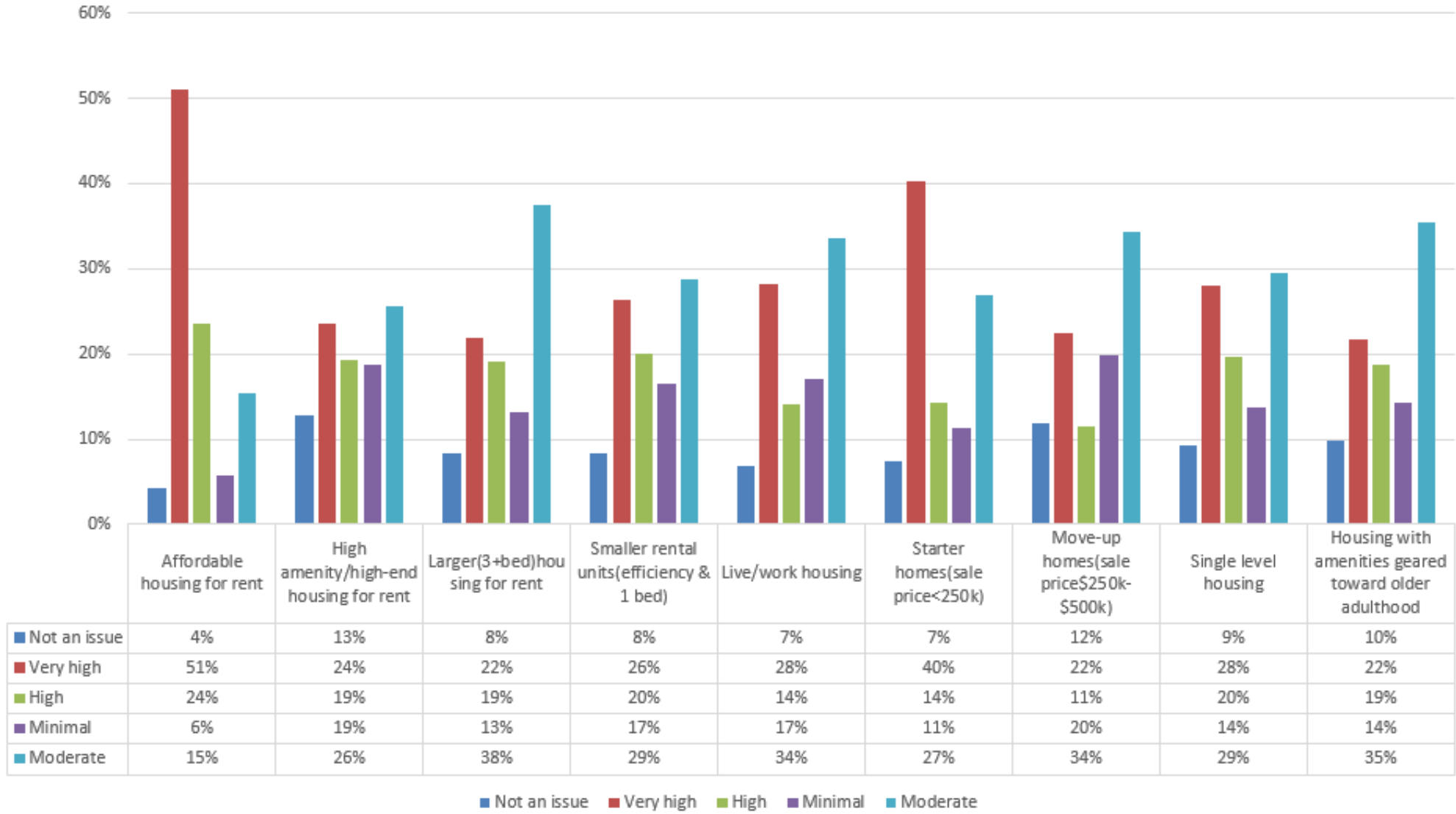
## How would you rate the current availability of housing options affordable

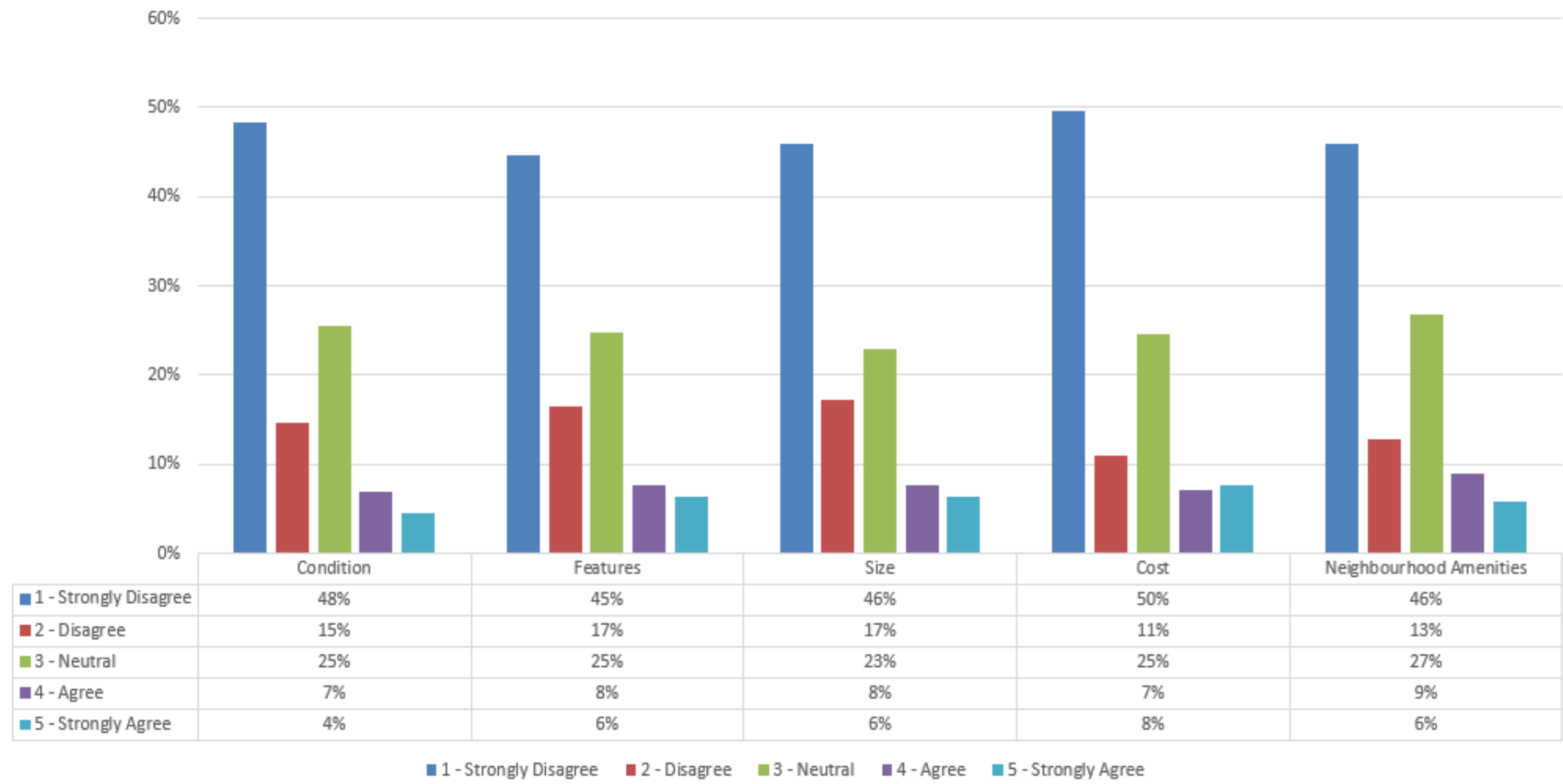

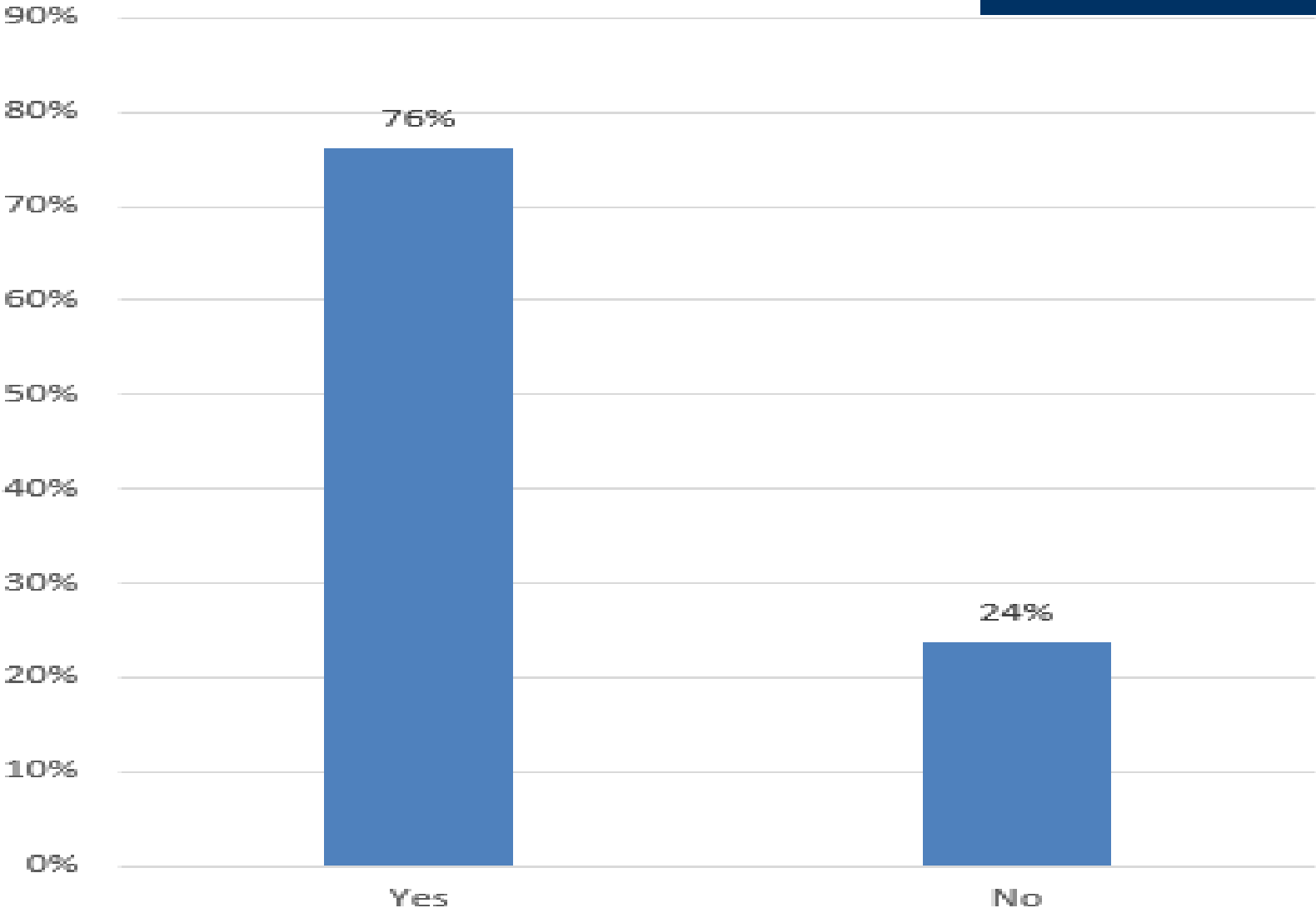

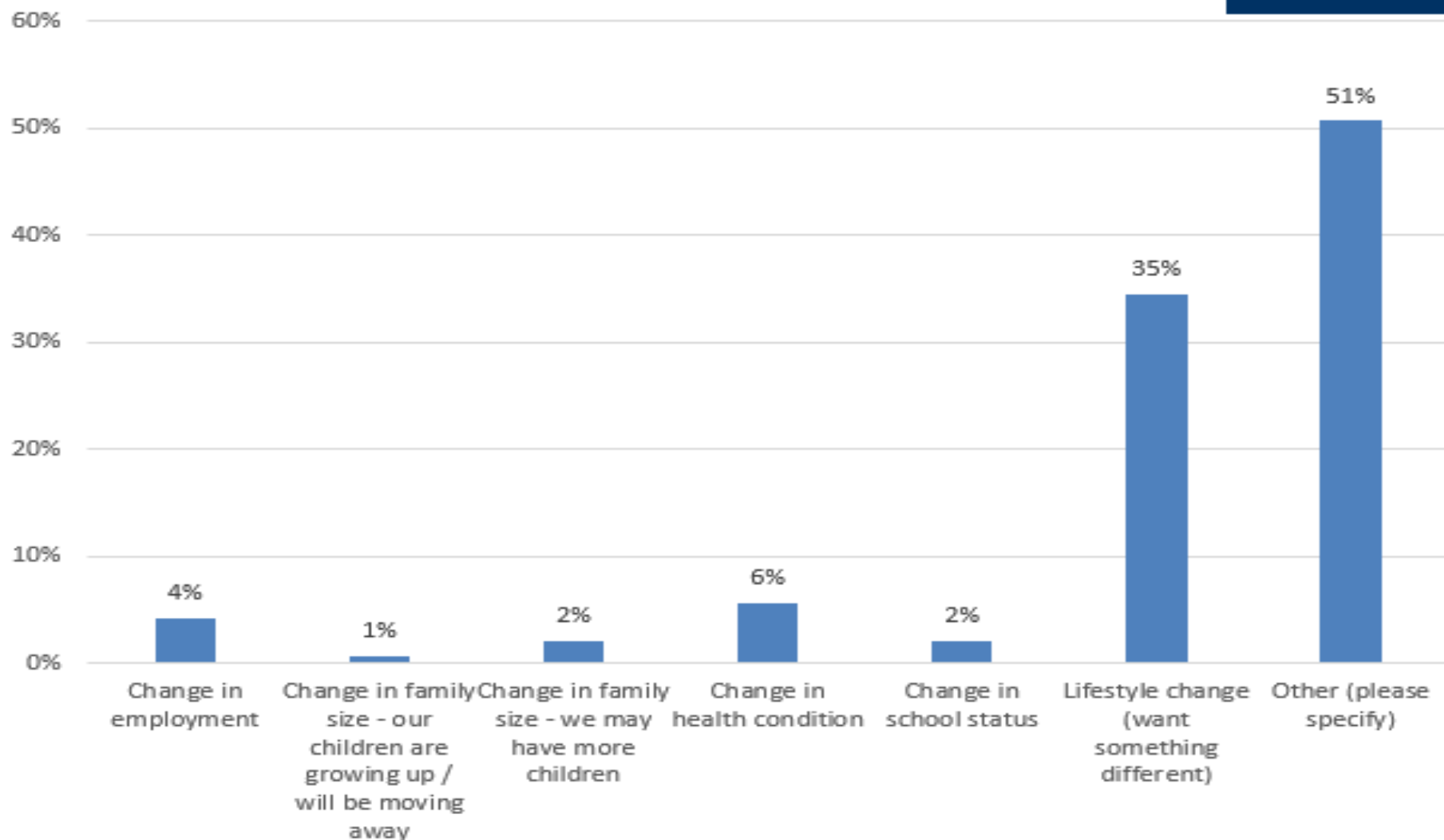

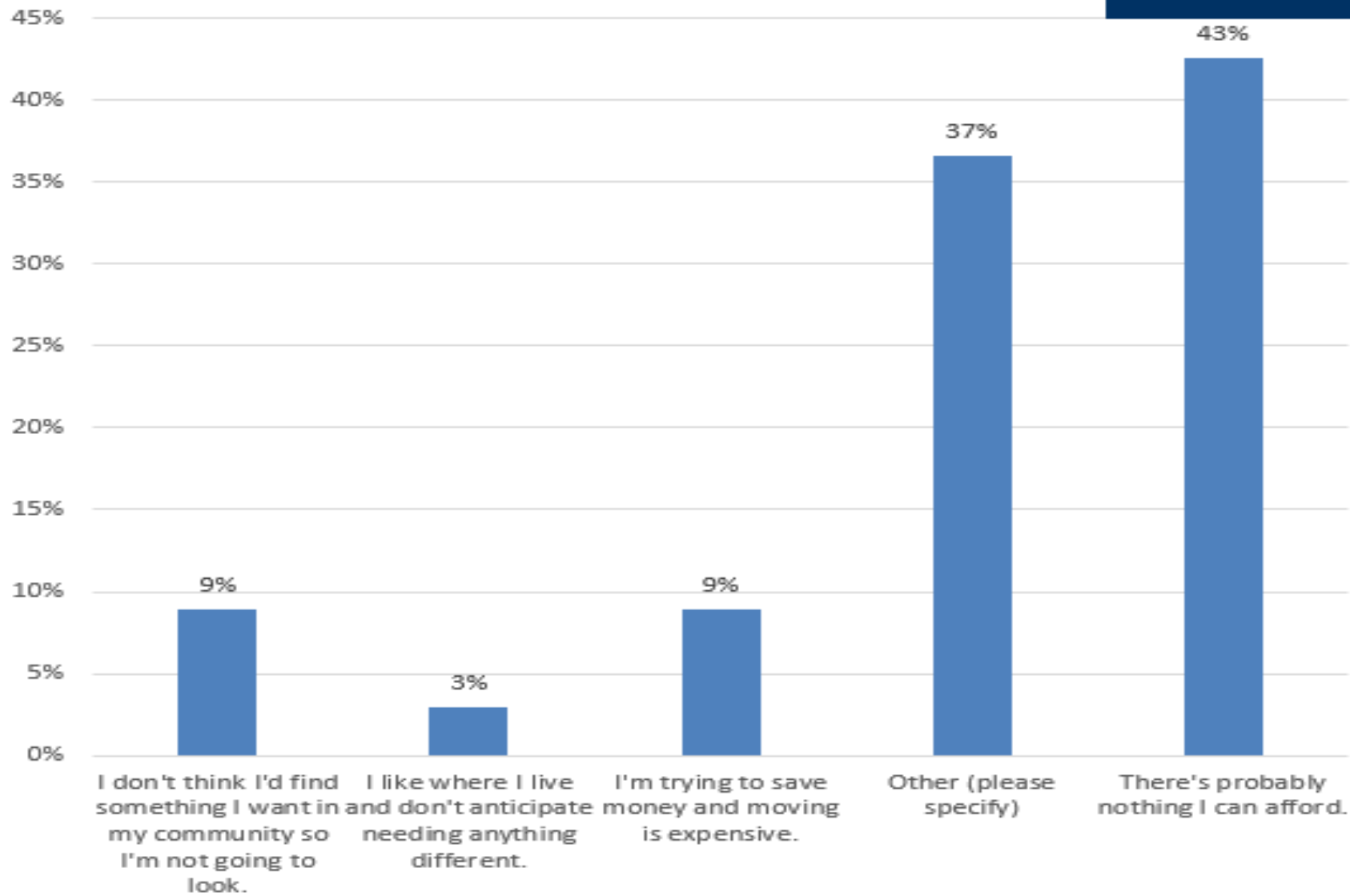

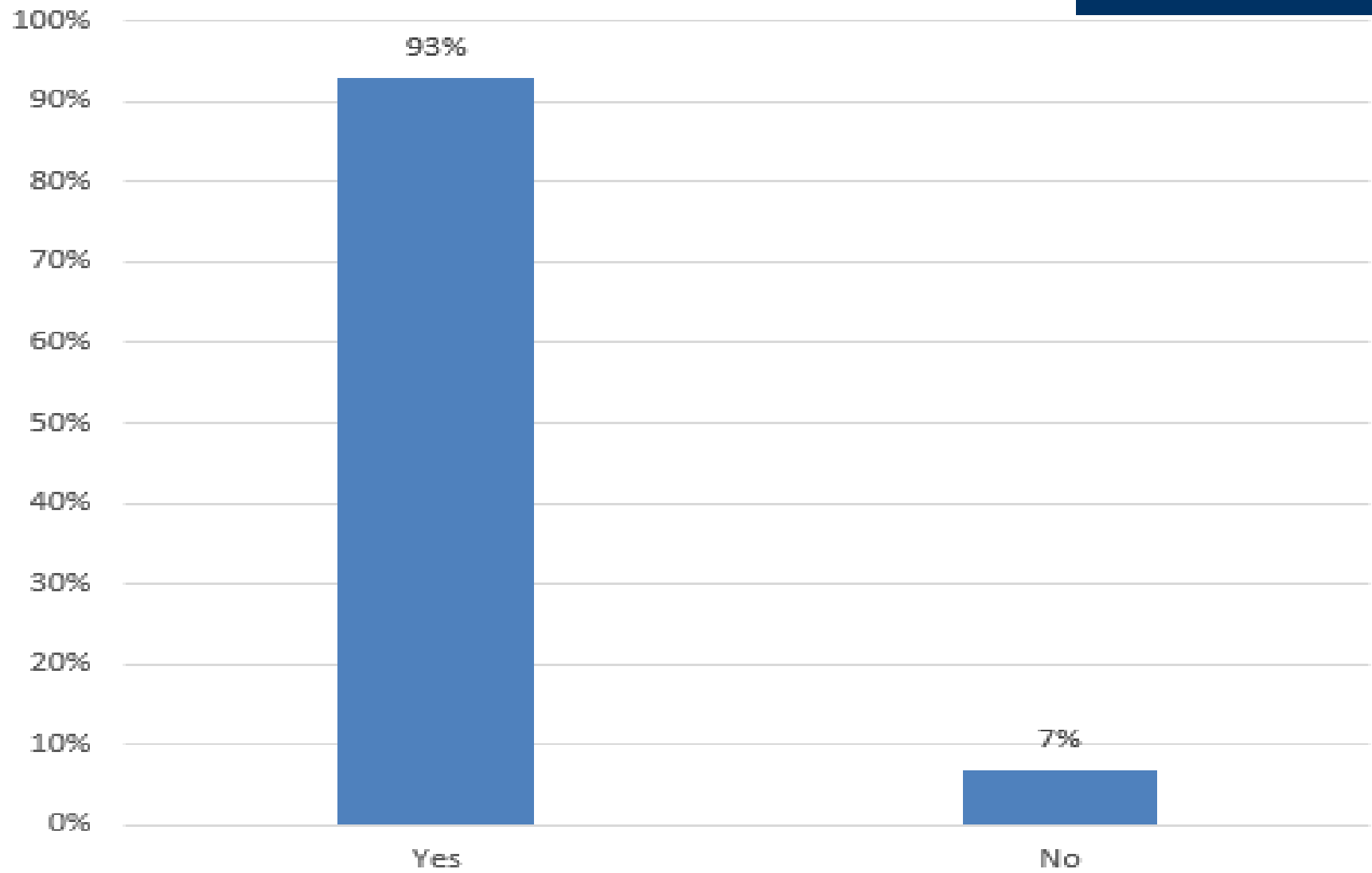
## If no, why do you plan to stay in your current home?

# Do you worry about housing costs?

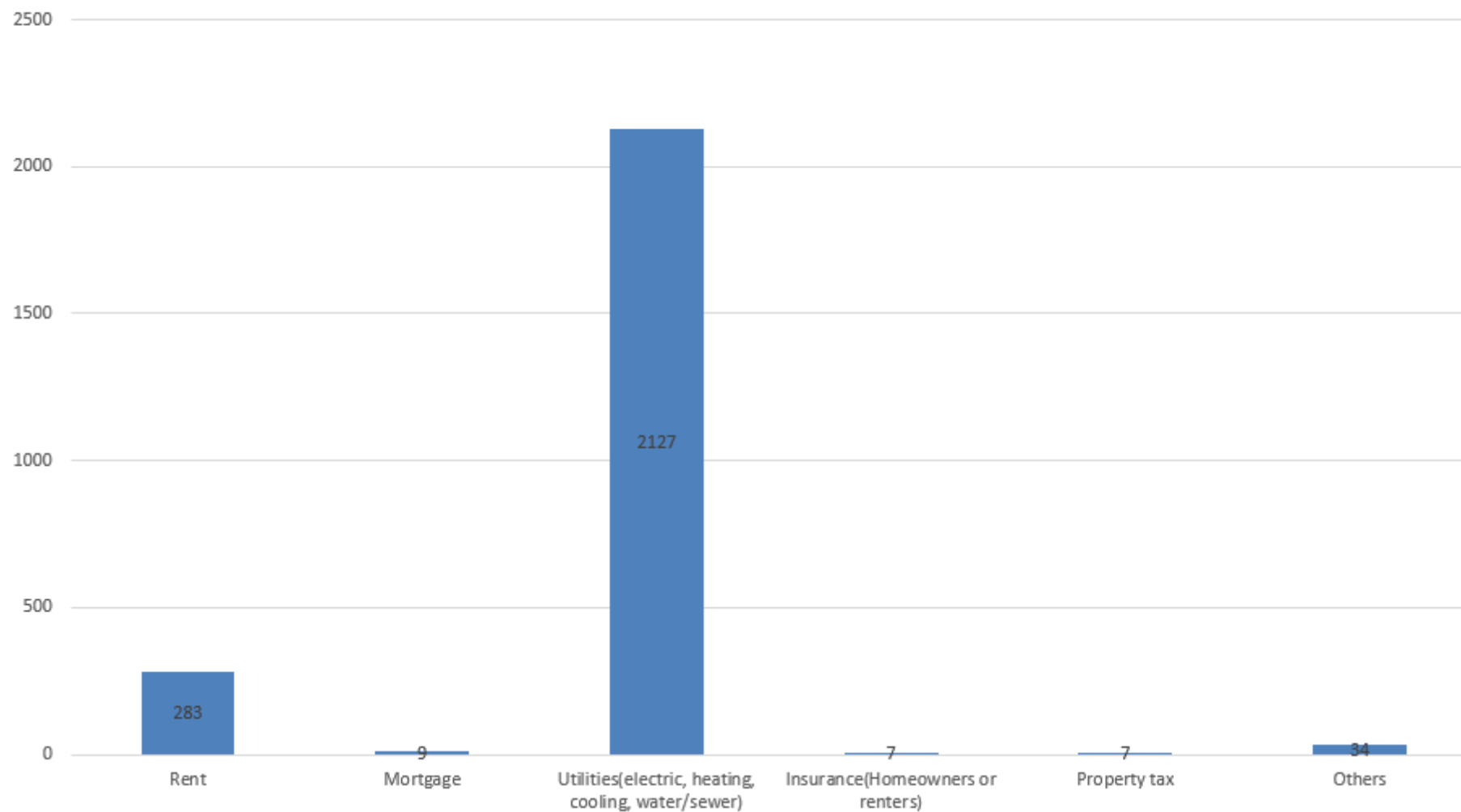

For housing to be considered "affordable" to you, it should not take up more than 30% of your gross (before tax) household income. What do you pay for housing today? (monthly costs)

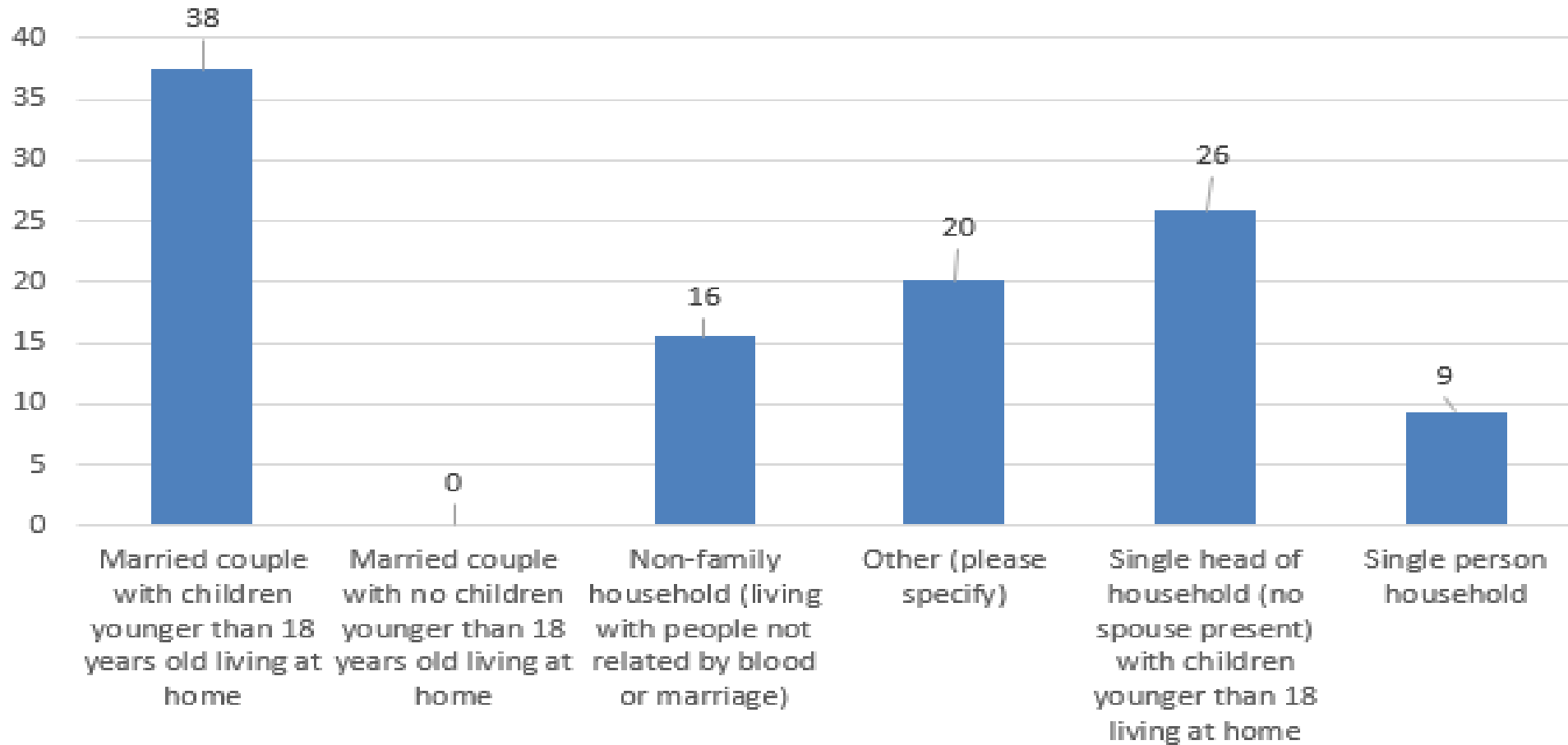

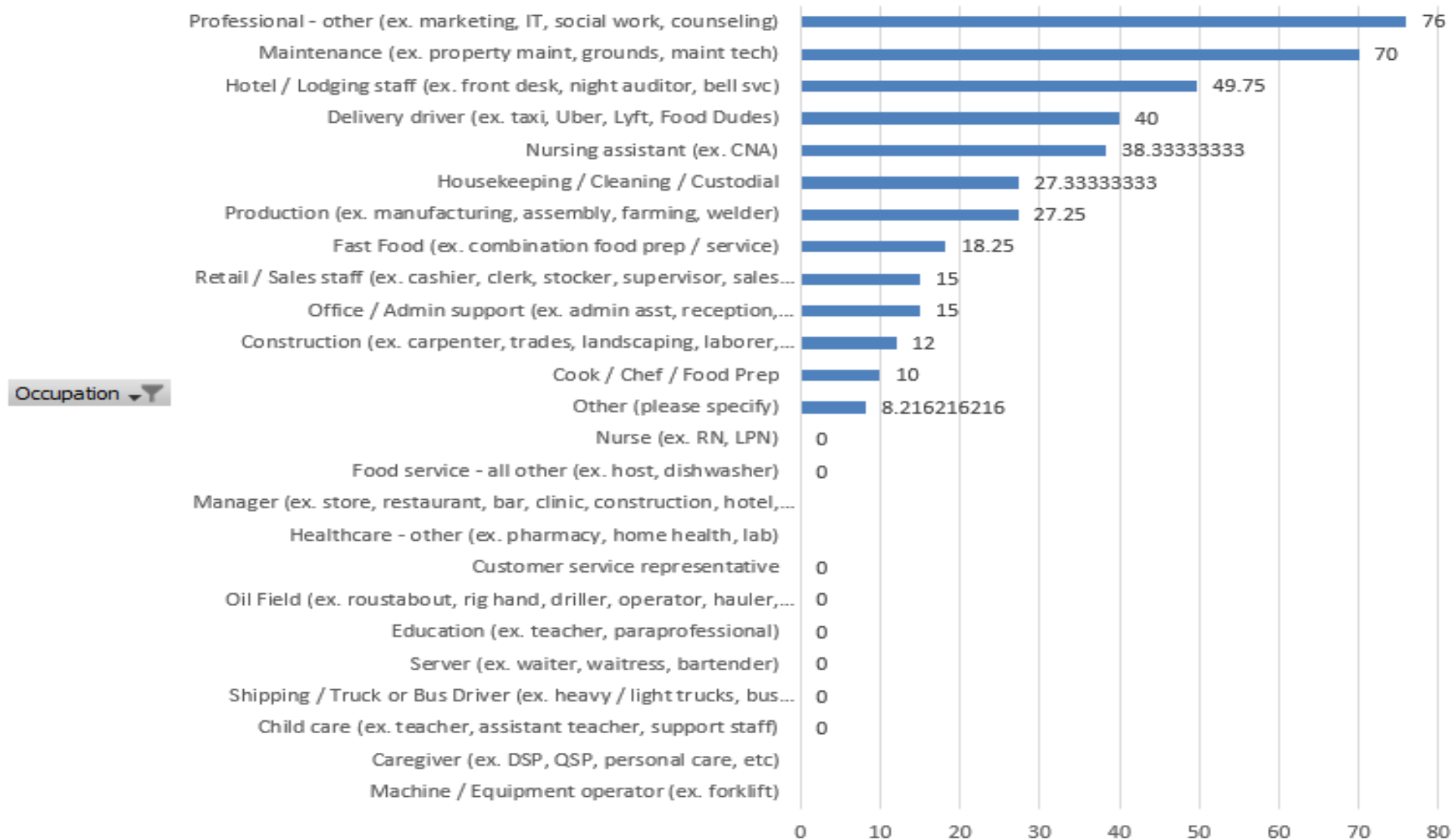
Average of Percentage of Income on Housing

What percentage of your total household income does your housing cost currently represent?

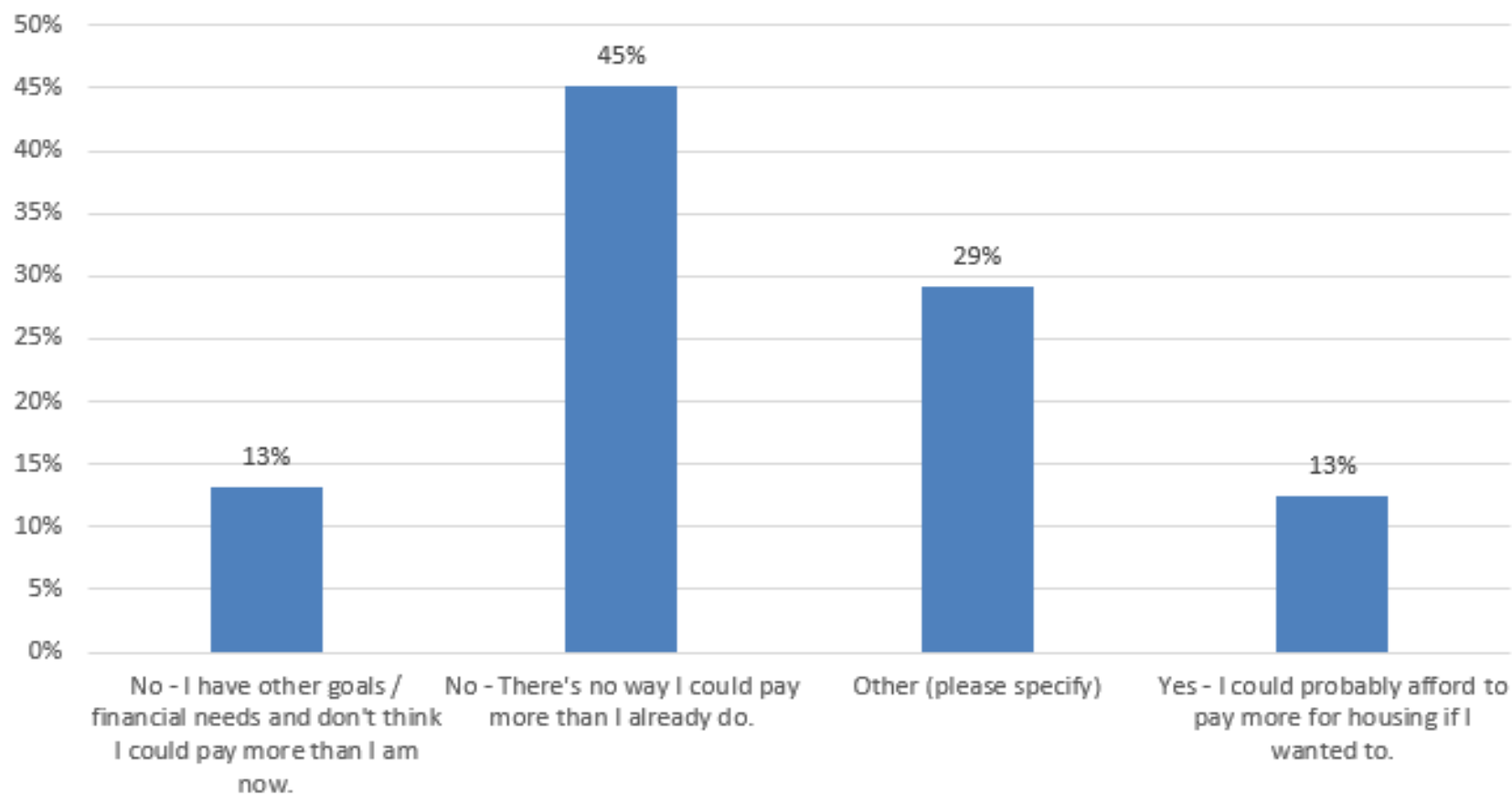


## Percentage of Income spent on Housing by Occupation
